

Devotion Guidelines:

1. Keep it short and interactive

2. Read the Scripture passage together with each person reading a verse 3. Ask questions about each verse

4. Ask each child how they will apply what they have learned from the verses. (Even your young children) You, as a parent, also share what you will apply. Remember that Bible study is for application and transformation not just for information.)

5. Pray together as a family (You and your children can take turns praying) - For each other's requests

- To ask for God's help to apply what you have learned

Read Together: Isaiah 6:1-8

1 In the year of King Uzziah's death I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, lofty and exalted, with the train of His robe filling the temple. 2 Seraphim stood above Him, each having six wings: with two he covered his face, and with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. 3 And one called out to another and said, "Holy, Holy, Holy, is the Lord of hosts, the whole earth is full of His glory." 4 And the foundations of the thresholds trembled at the voice of him who called out, while the temple was filling with smoke. 5 Then I said, "Woe is me, for I am ruined! Because I am a man of unclean lips, And I live among a people of unclean lips; For my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts." 6 Then one of the seraphim flew to me with a burning coal in his hand, which he had taken from the altar with tongs. 7 He touched my mouth with it and said, "Behold, this has touched your lips; and your iniquity is taken away and your sin is forgiven." 8 Then I said, "Here am I. Send me!"

Talk Together:

1. In verses 1-4, describe what Isaiah saw, heard, and experienced.

- 2. In verse 5, what did Isaiah realize about the Lord and about himself?
- 3. In verses 6-7, how did God solve his guilt and sin problem?

4. In verse 8, what is Isaiah's response to God's question?

Conviction:

God is Holy, I will humble myself and heed His call.

Application:

How will you respond to God's holiness? What is He calling you to do in your current situation?

Pray Together:

Dear Father, purify our hearts that we may live in a way that pleases and honors You. Empower us to do Your will and go where You want us to go. In Jesus' name, Amen.



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
