DEVOTION GUIDELINES

Keep it short and interactive.

 Read the Scripture passage together.

 Discuss how you and your family members will apply the lesson.

Pray for each other and ask for God's help to apply what you have learned.

READ TOGETHER

These are the 4 areas where Joseph experienced molding of his character by God.

PIT: Joseph was thrown into the pit and sold as a slave by his brothers (Genesis 37:2-8, 18-20, 23-24).

PRIVATE ROOM: Joseph was tempted but refused the advances of his master's wife (Genesis 39:1-4, 6-12).

PRISON: Joseph was sent to prison for a crime he did not commit (Genesis 39:13-23).

PALACE: Joseph interpreted Pharaoh's dream and was installed ruler of Egypt next to Pharaoh (Genesis 41:14-16, 38-43, Genesis 42:1-8, Genesis 45:1-8).

Genesis 50:20 As for you, you meant evil against me, but God meant it for good.

1. How did Joseph respond to his trials? What qualities did he have that allowed him to overcome all of them? 2. In what area of your life are you experiencing trials? How does Joseph's story change your view regarding trials? 3. Will you trust God's sovereignty and goodness over your trials? Why? How?
