A true NEW BEGINNING

Though we may be capable of becoming a better version of ourselves, there is a deepseated transformation that only divine intervention can make

possible. Jesus is the Only One who can give us a true new beginning that persists throughout our lifetime and continues forever! In Mark Chapter 5, we find the story of a desperate and hopeless man who was completely made new in Christ – a lasting and matchless life transformation that is available for everyone who put their faith in Him!

THE NEED FOR A NEW BEGINNING (Mark 5:1-5)

In Mark 5:1-2, Jesus and his disciples arrived by boat on the eastern side of the Sea of Galilee and were immediately met by a "demonized" man who lived among the tombs. Why did this man need a new beginning? He was spiritually dead! This "spiritual deadness" originated from Adam and Eve's disobedience to God (Genesis 2:16-17). When Adam and Eve ate the forbidden fruit, they did not die instantly, but they became spiritually separated from God. This is true for all of us as well. Before coming to Christ, we too were dead in our trespasses and sins (Ephesians 2:1-2). And though we may not be literally "demonized", we followed Satan's ways. All of us have lied at least once in our lives, a characteristic of Satan the deceiver. Like the man in the story, we are out. of control, desperately trying to find meaning and escape in the wrong places such as social media, alcohol, drug abuse, pornography, and even suicide. The truth is, we do not have the power to make a change on our own, we need Jesus. Until we recognize this, we cannot have the new beginning that we are longing for.

THE POWER FOR A NEW BEGINNING (Mark 5:6-17)

Jesus holds the power we need to experience a new beginning. He has ultimate and absolute authority over all things including nature (Mark 1:21-22; 4:37-41) and supernatural forces (Mark 5:6-8, 11-13, Luke 8:30-3). The devil seeks to destroy us, but Jesus came to destroy the works of the evil one and give us an abundant life (John 10:10, 1 John 3:8). That's why we cannot separate Christmas, the Resurrection, and the Return of Jesus – it's a "package deal" that He accomplished to save us and make us into a brand-new person, the old life is gone; a new life has begun (2 Corinthians 5:17). In the same way that Jesus has freed and restored the demonized man, we too can walk in newness of life through His Holy Spirit's power at work within us (Galatians 5:16, 22-23).

TELL OTHERS ABOUT THE NEW BEGINNING (Mark 5:18-20)

The response of the man set free by Jesus reminds us of how the shepherds responded to the angel's message about Christ. He went away and told others how much Jesus had done for him (Mark 5:18-20). This new year, let us tell those who need a new beginning, of Christ's power to have a true new beginning! This is our mission and vision as a church family (Matthew 28:18-20). As we face 2023, let us put our hope not in the New Year, but in the One who makes all things new. Let us experience a true new beginning in Christ, and help others do the same!
