VICTORIOUS FAITH BRINGS VICTORIOUS LIVING

LAST WEEK'S MESSAGE

No matter what our past is, God can transform us from the inside out and give us new life. We see this timeless truth come true in the life of Rahab, the pagan prostitute. Rahab encountered the grace of God, and her life was never the same. That is real faith! It is putting our trust in who God is, what He has done, His character, and His promises. In Joshua 2, we learn four aspects of Rahab's victorious faith.

CENTERED ON TRUTH (Joshua 2:1-11)

Joshua sent out 2 spies to survey the land of Jericho. He wants to come up with a strategy to conquer the land, but God had a higher purpose – to save Rahab and give the people of Israel victory! The king of Jericho found out that the spies stayed at Rahab's house. But Rahab hid and protected them. Why did she do this? Rahab knew about God's power. She knew He led the Israelites out of slavery from Egypt and how He gave them victory through their journey towards the Promised Land. Rahab was impacted by this truth. She acknowledged and believed that the "LORD is God in heaven above and on earth beneath". Like Rahab, we can have victorious faith when we trust in the reliable truth of God's character and His word.

COURAGEOUS

Rahab displayed courageous faith when she acted and risked her life to hide the spies. Hebrews 11:30-31 commends "Rahab the prostitute" for not siding with those who were "disobedient". The entire land of Jericho heard about God. They knew the same things that Rahab knew, but they did not acknowledge Him. James 2:24-26 uses Rahab as an example of faith in action. The evidence of genuine faith is transformed life, changed behavior, and fearless acts in obedience to God. Every act of obedience to God – to be honest, to keep our integrity, to refuse bribes, to stand against the tide and choose righteousness – takes courage! It is not the absence of fear, but a demonstration of complete trust in God (Psalm 56:3-4).

CONCERN FOR OTHERS (Joshua 2:12-16)

Rahab was concerned for the welfare of her family. She made sure that her family would be safe when the army of Joshua attacked Jericho. Do we have the same concern for others? If we genuinely love and care for our loved ones and other people, we will live in such a way that we point them to Jesus Christ. We need to intentionally reach out, pray for them, and share the gospel to them!

CONTINUING (Joshua 2:17-21)

The spies made a covenant with Rahab to spare her whole household when they attacked Jericho. She was asked to tie a scarlet cord at the window, so that all who lived in her house would be saved. This is symbolic of the blood on the doorposts during the Passover (Exodus 12:23), and ultimately, the blood that Christ shed for all of us for our salvation. Rahab tied a scarlet cord in the window and was saved (Joshua 6:22-23). Rahab's faith was enduring. She is part of Jesus' genealogy (Matthew 1:1-6), becoming one of Jesus' ancestors!

The story of Rahab tells us no one is beyond God's transforming grace. Our part is to be willing to change and embrace a new beginning like Rahab, whose victorious faith brought about a victorious life!




God brought you here for His purpose.
