TRAINING FOR VICTORIOUS FAITH

Victorious faith requires training and discipline, just like becoming a skilled athlete or musician. Similarly, Christians must train themselves to become good and victorious in their faith. Hebrews 12:11 states that discipline and training are not easy, but they yield the peaceful fruit of righteousness. In Joshua 3 and 4, we can learn three life training principles and apply them to our own faith journey:

LOOK TO JESUS

We must train our eyes to look to Jesus. Joshua 3:1-3 describes how Joshua led the Israelites across the Jordan River to proceed to Jericho, and key to this plan is the ark of the covenant, a symbol of the presence of God. The ark contains the tablets where the ten commandments were written (a reminder of God's holiness and will), the manna (a reminder of God's provision for them), and the rod that bloomed (a symbol of how God is able to bring life from death). The ark is also covered by the "mercy seat", an essential element in the religious practices of the Jewish nation. This serves as a reminder for us to live a holy life as we expect great things from God. In the New Testament, Hebrews 12:1-2 tells us to lay aside burdens, do away with sins, and persevere as we "FIX OUR EYES ON JESUS". Jesus is the author, meaning He initiated our salvation — He brought us up to this point of us deciding to follow Jesus. He is also the perfector: He molds our faith. When you come to Jesus, it is not just sacrifice and suffering. It's going to be worth it, especially when we have eternal perspective! Choose to FOCUS on Jesus!

LISTEN TO OBEY

We must train our ears to listen and obey God's word. Joshua 3:9-11 is where Joshua declares the word of the Lord. There was a promise given, but there were also clear instructions for them to do. We listen to God not just for that purpose, but also because we intend to obey whatever we hear from the Lord. When we hear instruction from the Lord, we must do exactly as the Lord has instructed us. James 1:22-25 commands us to be effectual doers, and not just forgetful hearers of the Word. If we want our faith to grow and make us victorious, we must learn to listen to God's Word and choose to obey, and not turn away from truth.

LAST WEEK'S MESSAGE

LIFE LEGACY

We must build a life legacy that reminds us of the victories we have achieved through our faith in God. God asked Joshua to take memorial stones and build a monument after the crossing (Joshua 4 onwards). It was meant to remind even future generations of the victories God had given them. Similarly, we should build a life legacy that reminds us of the victories we have achieved through our faith in God. This could be through journaling, sharing our testimony, or simply reflecting on the ways God has been faithful to us in the past.

Training for victorious faith involves discipline and stretching. Like Joshua, we can cross the Jordan Rivers of our life by fixing our eyes on Jesus, listening to and obeying His word, and leaving a legacy of faith - our lives — which showcases the faithfulness, power, and glory of God to those around us. By training ourselves in these ways, we can become good, victorious Christians!

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

What does it mean for you to "look to Jesus"? How can doing that prepare you for victory? How do you decide which voice to listen to (God or the world) when you face decision-making?

What do you think you should do to hear and be able to follow Him and not the world?
