DO NOT BE DECEIVED: **BE ON GUARD**

Deception is a formidable enemy that can cause even the most faithful of us to stumble. The Bible tells of two instances when Joshua made mistakes: one involving sin, and the other a deception. The good news is victory is promised by God. However, there are conditions to those promises. We got to know and do our part. How can be on quard and avoid deceptions?

CHECK IT OUT (JOSHUA 9:1-27)

In Joshua 9, Joshua set out to conquer the city of Gibeon after successful battles at Jericho and Ai. However, the Gibeonites set up a deception to avoid the Israelites' attack. Despite their suspicions, the Israelites fell for the lies and made an oath to the Gibeonites without seeking counsel from the Lord.

To avoid being deceived, we need to be on guard and check our thinking before making any decisions or commitments. In 2 Peter 3:17, we are warned to be on guard against false teachings and to not be carried away by them. In Acts 20:28, Paul tells his disciples to be on guard for themselves and for others, emphasizing the importance of guarding our own hearts and minds before we can help others. We also need to be aware that the battle is not physical but spiritual, and the key battleground is our minds. We need to take every thought captive and identify the strongholds in our minds that the enemy may use to deceive us. This requires a commitment to renewing our minds through studying the Word and seeking God's truth.

CONSULT GOD

We must seek God and make sure that whatever we do or think is in line with His will. In George Muller's words, "We must pray with a heart that has no will of its own and be ready for whatever the Lord's will may be." To do this, we must have a complete understanding of who God is - His nature and character. We must remember that God is sovereign, holy, good, omniscient, and loving. Whatever God does will not violate any of these characteristics, so we can fully trust in Him to do what is best for us when we follow and honor Him. However. we must also remember that God's grace is not infinite. As R.C. Sproul said, "God sets limits to His patience and forbearance." We cannot keep on sinning and expect to get away with it.

COMMIT TO GOD'S WAYS (JOSHUA 10:1-43)

Despite their deception, the Gibeonites were accepted by the Israelites and became servants of the Lord, serving faithfully for many years. (1 Chronicles 9:2, Nehemiah 3:7). This demonstrates that God's love, forgiveness, and faithfulness extends beyond our mistakes and shortcomings. As God is faithful to fulfill His promises, we should strive to be faithful in fulfilling our promises to Him, just as Joshua and the Israelites did. Their story teaches us that we should commit our mistakes to the Lord and keep on following Him. Instead of trying to correct one mistake with another, we should trust in God's power and sovereignty to redeem our failings as we come to Him in repentance and humility. Joshua's victory in conquering the lands was possible because he followed God's ways and committed the outcome to Him. God brought five kings together and defeated all their armies, throwing them into confusion and with large hailstones (Joshua 10:8-14).

Romans 8:28 is a powerful reminder that God can work all things together for good, even in bad moments. If we respond with faith and proper theology, think and act biblically, and commit the outcome to God, we will be victorious. So let us commit to God's ways, follow His commands, and trust in His plan for our lives.


