VICTORY OVER CONFLICT

LAST WEEK'S MESSAGE

In our lives, conflicts also happen closer to home. As we continue our series, let us find out how we can have victory over conflict through Joshua 22.

CHECK YOUR HEART (JOSHUA 22:1-9)

In Joshua 22:1-9, Joshua reminds the tribes of Reuben, Gad, and the half-tribe of Manasseh to be extremely careful to obey God's law, love the Lord, walk in His ways, keep His commandments, hold fast, and serve Him with all their heart. This reminder is crucial because it sets the tone for how the tribes should proceed into their own territories after helping their brothers conquer the areas west of the Jordan. This reminder is still applicable to us today, as we should always examine our own heart condition in dealing with conflicts. In 1 Peter 5:8, we are warned that the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. Therefore, it is crucial that we have our hearts in the right place before engaging in any kind of battle.

DON'T REACT, INTERACT (JOSHUA 22:10-18)

As they settled on the other side of the Jordan River, the said tribes built an altar which caused the remaining tribes to become upset and ready for battle. The reason for their anger was based on a commandment given by Moses that only the Lord could choose the place where they could worship and offer sacrifices, and the Lord had already chosen Shiloh on the west side of the Jordan River. However, instead of reacting to their assumptions and going to war, the remaining tribes chose to interact with the tribes of Reuben, Gad, and the half-tribe of Manasseh by sending Phineas the priest and a delegation of representatives from each tribe to find out what was really going on. This demonstrates the importance of suspending judgment before taking action, as we are urged in James 1:19-20. Interacting with others, seeking to understand their perspective, and suspending judgment can prevent misunderstandings and conflict in our lives.

FOCUS ON THE ISSUE AND RESOLUTION (JOSHUA 22:15-20)

In Joshua 22:15-29, instead of jumping to conclusions or making assumptions, the delegation approached the issue directly and sought to understand the intentions behind the building of the altar rather than attacking. In the same way, when we inquire, listen, and seek to understand the people we are in conflict with, we're able to avoid misunderstandings and focus on finding a solution. It is crucial to use the right language when addressing the issue. An example of this is avoiding "always" or "never" statements, which can come across as judgmental and accusatory and lead to defensiveness and further conflict. Instead, using "I feel..." statements can help express our emotions and concerns without attacking the other person.

HONOR GOD AND RESPOND HUMBLY (JOSHUA 22:21-34)

Rather than becoming defensive or argumentative, the tribes of Reuben, Gad, and half of Manasseh responded with gentleness and humility to their brothers, which is a sign of wisdom (Proverbs 15:1, 1 Peter 5:5, Colossians 3:12-13). Sometimes, during conflict, we may find it challenging to respond with humility. This may be because we have not yet forgiven the other person. Forgiveness is a crucial step in resolving conflict and responding with humility. We must choose to forgive the other person, even if they never change, and choose to love them unconditionally. This is the standard that God calls us to in our relationships (Colossians 3:14). The gentle and humble response of these tribes not only resolved the conflict but also pleased the rest of the Israelite tribes. This is because their response honored God and demonstrated a higher standard of conduct. When we follow God's word in our relationships, we bring glory to Him.


