

JESUS IS RISEN! HE CHANGES EVERYTHING

LAST WEEK'S MESSAGE

Permacrisis is a word that describes a constant state of instability and insecurity due to a series of catastrophic events, just like what we have witnessed and gone through the past couple of years – the pandemic, the war in Ukraine, tensions between superpowers, and natural disasters. But perhaps more than anything else, it is the crisis in our own lives that makes us feel like our world is falling apart. We ask, “When will these things end?”. Jesus said that in this world, we will have trouble and things will get worse as we approach the end of this age. However, we can find real assurance and comfort in JESUS, our LIVING HOPE (1 Peter 1:3). Let’s look at how Jesus made a difference in the lives of those who first witnessed His resurrection and how He can make changes for us who believe in Him today!

PAIN

Are you currently experiencing pain in your life? Jesus can turn sorrow into joy, just as He did with Mary Magdalene (John 20:11-16). There may be times when we feel like God is nowhere to be found amidst our pain. But Jesus knows our hurts. He knows us and calls us by name. He is a personal and compassionate Savior, who can turn our sorrow into joy.

Jesus can also turn our fear into peace! The disciples were afraid after Jesus died, and they feared that His enemies would come after them. But then Jesus appeared to them and offered them His peace (John 20:19-21). Fear makes us feel like our lives are falling apart, and we don’t know how to put our world back together again. The peace that Jesus gives takes away our fears, even if our challenging circumstances has not changed.

Finally, Christ turns our doubt into faith. Like Thomas, who first doubted and finally believed, our only response to the risen Jesus should be, “My Lord and my God” (John 20:24-29).

PERSPECTIVE

Jesus changes our perspective from earthly to eternal. Even if some people believe that they have the tenacity and ability to overcome crises on their own, we will all face the final crisis of life: will we be with the Lord for eternity or not? Because Jesus has been resurrected, He is the Only One who can give us forgiveness of sins and eternal life (1 Corinthians 15:16-19, 50-55). Heaven is a real place. God has reserved it for those who believe in the risen Savior (Revelation 21:1-5). Heaven is what it is because of the presence of God with us, His people, face to face with Jesus. The Lord will make all things new in the new heavens and the new earth, and that’s why Jesus is the real change maker! By believing in Jesus, we can receive forgiveness of sins and the promise of eternal life, and this can radically change our perspective and give us hope for the future.

PURPOSE

The transformation that happened to the Apostle Paul is a testament to the life-changing power of encountering the risen Jesus. Paul was a zealous persecutor of Christians, but after he met the Lord on the road to Damascus, his life was forever changed. He went from being an enemy of the gospel to being one of its greatest champions, dedicating his life to spreading the good news of Jesus Christ to the world. This shows us that there is no one beyond the reach of God’s transforming love and power. Jesus offers us the promise of new life and a new beginning, no matter what we have done or where we have been, and this is available to anyone who believes in Jesus as their Lord and Savior.

Jesus said, “I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies and everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die” (John 11:25-26). How will you respond to His invitation today?
