LAST WEEK'S MESSAGE

SURRENDERED LEADER IS A POSITIVE INFLUENCER

Whether we like it or not, we are all influencers. The only question is: are we a positive or negative influence on others? To become a POSITIVE INFLUENCER, we need to be a SURRENDERED LEADER. We can look to the example of Moses, who submitted to God's plan, relied on His power, and sought His glory.

GOD'S PLAN

In Acts 7:30-34, we see the well-known story of Moses and the burning bush. God often uses something eye-catching to grab our attention, just like the burning bush did for Moses. Moses was led to the wilderness where he was open and ready to listen. God took the initiative to reach out to him and reveal Himself. In encountering God, we become more aware of our own sinfulness and God's holiness. Moses feared God and realized who was in charge. God revealed that He knew about the struggles and pains of the Israelites and had a plan to deliver them, which included sending Moses back to Egypt. Exodus 3:10 highlights God's plan for Moses to set the people of Israel free. Moses made the choice to follow God, despite the cost of comfort, fear, and worry. He had an eternal perspective and chose to endure ill-treatment instead of the fleeting pleasures of sin. Following God is not martyrdom — it's wise and the logical thing to do.

GOD'S POWER

Moses presented several excuses to God when he was tasked with leading the Israelites out of Egypt. He asked, "Who am I?" and "What is Your name?" (Exodus 3:11-15). He also expressed doubt about his abilities, saying he was slow of speech and tongue (Exodus 4:10-12). However, God encouraged him to go forth and serve, assuring him that He would provide the power. Despite Moses' doubts, God chose him to be His instrument. Similarly, Jesus promised in Acts 1:8 that the Holy Spirit would provide the power needed to fulfill His commands. We cannot do it alone, but we can partner with God's power. As Moses led the Israelites out of Egypt, they came to the Red Sea, and the Egyptians pursued them. Moses cried out to God, who commanded him to divide the sea (Exodus 14:13-16). As Moses obeyed, the sea was divided, and the Israelites crossed safely. This is a powerful reminder of God's faithfulness and His ability to do the impossible.

SEEK GOD'S GLORY

In the time of Moses, the people were exceedingly idolatrous, and God was ready to destroy them because of their obstinacy. He offered to start over with Moses, but Moses, in Exodus 32:11-12, showed that his concern was for God's glory. He pleaded with God to spare the people, reminding Him of His promises to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. However, Moses was not perfect, and he made a mistake that caused him to lose the privilege of entering the Promised Land. In Deuteronomy 3:25-26, he pleaded with God to let him enter the land, but God refused. Moses accepted this decision and even appointed a leader, Joshua, to lead the people as per God's instruction in Numbers 27:18-20, 23. Moses' life teaches us that seeking God's glory should be the primary focus of our lives. Our concern should not be for our own comfort or success, but rather for bringing honor and glory to God in everything we do.

It's common for us to aspire and have goals, and at times we may think that God is obligated to fulfill them. However, our ambitions can easily become an idol, and the solution is to become a leader who surrenders these desires to God. When God places a dream in our hearts, we must trust that He has all of eternity to fulfill it. Even though Moses was not allowed to enter the Promised Land due to a mistake he made, we learn from Matthew 17 that he did eventually reach his destination. In fact, during the Transfiguration, Jesus showed that Moses was present on the mountain with Him.

Choosing rather to endure ill-treatment with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin, considering the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures of Egypt; for he was looking to the reward.
