

BE A CHANGEMAKER WITH A STRONG HEART

LAST WEEK'S MESSAGE

Compromise refers to the act of making concessions or adjustments to find a common ground or a middle point between two or more conflicting parties. It can be a useful way in resolving disputes or conflicts in various settings such as politics, business, or personal relationships, but when it comes to following God's principles, we must be unwavering in standing for our faith and making up our mind to obey God at all costs. Giving in to pressures from within ourselves or outside influences such as peers, social media, or authority figures could hinder our ability to become positive "changemakers" for the Lord. Daniel, a captive of King Nebuchadnezzar in Babylon, faced intense pressure to abandon his worship of the God of Israel and conform to Babylonian culture. As Christians, we also face pressure to compromise our faith and convictions. To be a strong "changemaker" for God, we must learn from the example of Daniel who had a strong heart that is devoted to God. How can we have a strong heart like him?

CONVICTION

Developing godly convictions is essential for followers of Christ, as they help us resist the pressures to compromise our faith and values. Daniel's conviction to not defile himself with the king's food was rooted in his faith and devotion to God. He recognized that eating these foods would not only go against God's commands but also imply allegiance to Babylon's false gods. We too can form godly convictions by regularly immersing ourselves in God's word and prayer. By doing so, we can better understand God's character and will, and as a result, our minds and hearts will be transformed to reflect His values and priorities. Being accountable to a community of believers, such as a discipleship group, can help us stay on track and receive support when facing pressure. Ultimately, Jesus is the foundation of our convictions as believers in Christ. We follow His teachings and example, and His truth guides us in every area of life. By remaining anchored in Him, we can have the strength and courage to stand firm in our faith, even in the face of opposition or temptation to compromise.

CONSIDERATE

When we have strong convictions about God and His ways, it is easy for us to become prideful and combative towards those who do not share our beliefs. However, this is not the attitude that we should have as believers. Instead, we should strive to be gracious, loving, and polite to all people, just as God is to us. Daniel and his friends exemplified this kind of humility and wisdom in their response to the king's commands. Daniel resolved not to defile himself with the king's food, but he did not do so in a confrontational or judgmental way. Instead, he appealed to the authority in a respectful manner, showing that he was humble and wise. As a result, God gave him wisdom and favor before the commander, as we see in Daniel 1:10-16.

COURAGE

Daniel's unwavering faith and courage to obey God in the face of opposition and persecution serve as an inspiring example for us. He did not fear the consequences of obeying God, even if it meant being thrown into the lions' den (Daniel 6:10). Throughout his life, he remained faithful to God, and this faithfulness had a powerful impact on the kings he served. Daniel's commitment to God led to the conversion of the Persian king, Darius. When Darius saw God's faithfulness in delivering Daniel from the lions' den, he declared that everyone in his kingdom must revere the God of Daniel.

We also have the privilege to become changemakers in the world. It may not always be easy, but we can trust in the Lord to take care of the results as we follow His ways. The reason why it is worth obeying God is because of Jesus! He died for us and rose again, and there is nowhere else where we can experience that kind of love but with Him as our Savior and Lord. Be a changemaker with a strong heart today.
