WORD

READ IT!

1 CORINTHIANS 14:1-5, 12 (READ THE ENTIRE CHAPTER FOR CONTEXT)

Pursue love, yet desire earnestly spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophesy. ² For one who speaks in a tongue does nots peak to men but to God; for no one understands, but in his spirit he speaks mysteries. ³ But one who prophesies speaks to men for edification and exhortation and consolation. ⁴ One who speaks in a tongue edifies himself; but one who prophesies edifies the church. ⁵ Now I wish that you all spoke in tongues, but even more that you would prophesy; and greater is one who prophesies than one who speaks in tongues, unless he interprets, so that the church may receive edifying. ¹² So also you, since you are zealous of spiritual gifts, seek to abound for the edification of the church.
