LAST WEEK'S MESSAGE

Know God's Will, Be Consecrated

We spend 80% of our total waking hours working, so it is important that we know God's will for us at work so we do not waste a moment of our life. God's desire is for us to know His will for our life. In Romans 12:1-8 we can find the key to knowing God's will, which is to consecrate our bodies as a living and holy sacrifice that is pleasing to Him.

CONSECRATE YOUR BODY (Romans 12:1)

When we dedicate our entire life to God, we surrender ownership of our body to Him. We follow and do whatever God wants us to do rather than according to our own self-will. It is a total surrender and commitment done out of complete trust in God. It has the idea of dying to ourselves, being crucified with Christ, and living by faith in Him (Galatians 2:20). We make it our goal to be pleasing to Him and allow Him to work in and through us to do the things He wants us to do.

CONSECRATE YOUR INTELLECT (Romans 12:2-3)

Consecrating our intellect is to not be conformed and molded by the patterns of the world. How do we do this? Psalm 1:1-3 and Joshua 1:18 shows us the value of delighting and meditating in the law of the LORD and receiving the blessing of goodness and success when we walk faithfully according to His word and His ways. 2 Corinthians 10:4-5 says that our battles are not of the flesh – we are in an ongoing spiritual warfare, and we should "take every thought captive to the obedience of Christ".

CONSECRATE YOUR GIFTS (Romans 12:4-8)

The Christian life is never meant to be lived for ourselves. We are all given opportunities to serve one another. We are gifted with talents and spiritual gifts (for example, prophecy, service, teaching, exhorting, giving, leading, showing mercy), and we must exercise it accordingly.

In Acts 7:22-44 we find a three-part account of Moses' life. First, he was a prince, then he was a simple shepherd, and finally at the age of 80, God took the initiative to give Moses a mission. Moses surrendered

completely and followed God all the way. Moses led Israel out of Egypt, showing God's work and power as he obeyed Him step by step.

As we seek to consecrate ourselves to God, let us be reminded and encouraged by these words from Campus Crusade for Christ founder, Dr. Bill Bright:

"A slave doesn't have rights. A slave does not own what he pours his life blood into. A slave of Jesus is at peace, no matter what the circumstances, because he can completely trust his good and faithful master... I am a slave of Jesus. It is not the responsibility of the slave to be successful; the only responsibility of a slave is to do what the master asks him to do. When you understand this, you will also understand a slave does not have problems; a slave only has opportunities to see the Master work."

May we all learn to know God's will for our lives, and continue to consecrate our lives, our work, and our decisions to Him. May we live our lives constantly glorifying Him in everything we think, say, or do!


