Choose Wisely

LAST WEEK'S MESSAGE

Many people do not understand MONEY properly. The reality is that there are many Bible verses about money and how our attitude about it reveals the true condition of our hearts. Luke 19:6-9 and Matthew 19:21-26 shows us the encounters Jesus had with people who had issues with wealth and possessions. More than the issue of money, Jesus addressed the heart and faith of people. Our choices on spending, saving, and even working to earn exposes what or who rules over our life, impacting our future. Therefore, we are to CHOOSE WISELY, and to do that, we need to understand the THEOLOGY of MONEY:

TWO TREASURES (MATTHEW 6:19-21)

In Matthew 6:19, Jesus talks about two treasures. The first is earthly treasure which can be destroyed and stolen. The second is heavenly treasures which can never be destroyed or stolen. God is not against earthly treasures or money. But what God desires is for us to have TRUE TREASURES. He doesn't want us to waste our lives going after the wrong ones, because where our treasure is, there our heart will be also. Where we invest, dedicate, and put our efforts in, there our heart and passion will also be. 1 Timothy 6:10 points out that it is not money but the "THE LOVE OF MONEY" which is the root of all evil. Materialism, greed, and covetousness are dangerous subtle sins that anybody can fall right into. While money is an instrument used by God to provide for our needs, it is also used by the enemy to draw us away from God – our first love. How do we deal with money and earthly treasures so that it brings glory to God? In Proverbs 6:6-8, prudence and saving up is encouraged. We are commanded to work and earn so that we will be able to help and bless others. In this way, we can convert earthly treasures into heavenly treasures and bring glory to God.

TWO PERSPECTIVES (MATTHEW 6:22-23)

Our human eyes are likened to windows – we must pray for the eyes of our heart to be enlightened (Ephesians 1:8). When our perspective is clear, our life will be full of light; if not, it will be full darkness. The theology of money tells us that money is neutral, but we need to have the right perspective. Until our perspective changes, we will only view life on the temporal level. In Luke 12:15, Jesus gave a warning: He asked for our eyes to be open. We need to guard ourselves and be aware of what's going on in our hearts. We must understand that money is not just for our own enjoyment. A sobering reality was given in Luke 12:20-21: we do not bring our money with us when our day comes! Unopened eyes and an unchanged perspective can derail even our eternal direction.

TWO MASTERS (MATTHEW 6:24-25)

All of us tend to place something over and above God. Whatever that is, we are doomed! We are to choose the RIGHT GOD. If our God is the God of the Bible, we can stop worrying and be at peace knowing that God is also our Heavenly Father who loves us and cares for us (Matthew 6:31-34). We can trust Him completely to provide for all our needs because He owns everything. Not only will he provide, but He will also use us mightily when He is Master and Lord over our lives. The late Dr. Bill Bright and his wife had a contract with God which showed total surrender to Him: to do whatever He wants them to do, go wherever He wants them to go, and say whatever He wants them to say. That contract surrendered everything to God. The most important decision is to see Jesus as our one and only Master. Joshua 24:15 reminds us to CHOOSE WHO WE WILL SERVE - and we need to choose wisely. As Joshua stated, may we also make that commitment, TO SERVE THE LORD. If we make Him Master of our lives, we will be able to make very important decisions and actions that will glorify God.
