# Discover the Best Use of Money

LAST WEEK'S MESSAGE

In Acts 20:35, the apostle Paul quoted a very famous statement declared by Jesus: "It is more blessed to give than to receive." Giving is the best use of money because it honors God, it blesses others, and it reaps rewards.

### **GIVING HONORS GOD**

Psalm 24:1 and Deuteronomy 8:18 tell us that the earth and all it contains belongs to the Lord. He is the owner and source of all things, including wealth and the ability to produce it. The proper response is to steward and use them wisely in a way that honors and glorifies Him.

In Malachi 3:5,8-10, God had issues against His people because they dishonored Him with their ungodly ways, including robbing Him in their tithes and offerings. We honor God through tithing. The tithe is 10% of one's gain be it fruit, animals, or money. In today's context, a tithe is a tenth of our income from employment, business, and other sources that we offer to the Lord and helps ensure there are resources available for God's work and workers. We see the examples of tithing even before the giving of the Law to Moses (Leviticus 27:30). Such examples are of Abraham in Genesis 14:18-20 and Jacob in Genesis 28:20-22.

Tithing is an act of obedience. It enables us to prove our faith in God as the source of all things. The bottom line is that giving to the Lord deals with our heart attitude — He wants us to give cheerfully as we desire to honor Him (2 Corinthians 9:6-7).

### **GIVING BLESSES OTHERS**

Giving is a privilege for all of God's people, not only the rich but even those with humble means (1 Timothy 6:17-18). We see this in 2 Corinthians 8:1-5 when the Apostle Paul was raising money among churches in Macedonia for the poor churches in Jerusalem. The Macedonian churches gave joyfully and generously even from their deep poverty. They were all able to give despite their humble means is because they understood that they can never outgive God and that He will take care of all their need. They had an intimate relationship with God which allowed them to trust Him fully in their giving and being a blessing to others.

### **GIVING REAPS REWARDS**

Luke 6:38 tells us to "Give, and it will be given to you. They will pour into your lap a good measure – pressed down, shaken together, and running over. For by your standard of measure it will be measured to you in return." We reap blessings by giving cheerfully and generously to honor God and bless others. Sometimes God's blessing is not in what he gives, but in what He prevents (Malachi 3:11-12). Our Gracious God Himself is the greatest blessing. He is our deliverer and protector. He is faithful to preserve His own.

For us to be able to give, we need to first have an encounter with the Ultimate Giver Himself. The beautiful truth about giving is that more than 2,000 years ago, God gave us what we needed most: the offer of forgiveness and redemption through His only Son, Jesus Christ. When God gives, we receive. May you receive the gift of eternal life found in Jesus Christ today.


