# **Pursue Great Gain**

LAST WEEK'S MESSAGE

God wants us to pursue and experience great gain or "abundance" (John 10:10). It is an abundant life that overflows with all that God blesses us with to do His work for His glory. What does it mean to pursue great gain and abundance?

In 1 Timothy 6:6, Paul tells his disciple Timothy (and us as well) the formula to pursuing great gain, and that is: Godliness + Contentment = Great Gain. It may seem counter-intuitive because gain is commonly perceived as acquiring more. However, Paul says that gain is accompanied by contentment. How do we put this into practice?

#### HAVE A STOPOVER MINDSET (1 TIMOTHY 6:7)

When we travel, we encounter "stopovers". These are quick breaks as we travel to and from our destination and we do not stay in our stopovers. Similarly, the stopover mindset is one that says, as the verse reminds us, that we brought nothing into the world and thus we can't also take anything from it (1 Timothy 6:7; Hebrews 13:14). So travel light and hold the things of this world lightly. Ask yourself: What am I tightly holding onto in my life?

#### **APPRECIATE THE SIMPLE THINGS**

#### (1 TIMOTHY 6:8)

Paul tells Timothy, "If we have food and covering, with these we shall be content." Jesus Himself taught us to pray, "Give us today our daily bread." These remind us to be content, grateful, and appreciate the simple things. Contentment does not encourage us to be passive; instead we are responsible to work to provide ourselves with our essentials (1 Timothy 5:8). We must be able to distinguish "wants" from "needs". A quote from Pastor Rick Warren encapsulates this point. He said, "A lot of things we think are needs, are actually just greeds. God did not say He will supply all our greeds." Ask yourself: Am I okay with having just a little? Do I appreciate the simple things?

#### **RE-DIRECT OUR DESIRES (1 TIMOTHY 6:9-11)**

To develop deep contentment, we need to beware of the trap of covetousness and greed. The Bible warns us against wanting more stuff, covetousness, and the love of money. We are to flee and stay away from places and people that pressure us to live a lifestyle that we cannot afford. Instead, we must redirect our passions and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, perseverance, and gentleness (1 Timothy 6:11b). When we covet and grab, we lose more. But when we desire God and His ways, He blesses us. We need to redirect our desire for things instead to Jesus (Psalm 17:15; Psalm 37:4). Ask yourself: What desires do I need to redirect?

### FIGHT THE GOOD FIGHT (1 TIMOTHY 6:12)

To cultivate an attitude of contentment, we need to evaluate our priorities. Are we consumed with our own endeavors or are we fighting the good fight of faith to obey God in sharing the gospel and making disciples (Matthew 28:19-20)? We may face discouragements along the way, but if Jesus has brought us to it, He will surely enable us to go through it (Hebrews 13:5). God promises that those who seek the Him will lack no good thing (Psalm 34:10). Ask yourself: Am I fighting the good fight 100%?

If you are not yet fighting to accomplish God's work, join in! If you are thinking of stepping back, keep fighting! God will provide all you need. As Hudson Taylor wisely said, "God's work done God's way will not in lack God's resources." If you want to experience this abundant life in Jesus, pray for Him to transform your life today.


