Good News, Bad News: SHARE THE GOOD NEWS!

Last Week's Message

The Book of Romans is the most comprehensive when it comes to theology, but more than that, it has transformed many lives, including great men of faith like St. Augustine, Martin Luther, and John Wesley. The Book of Romans is about the RIGHTEOUSNESS OF GOD as revealed in the Gospel. Let's explore the 3CPRs of the Gospel:

Comes from God (Romans 1:1-2)

The word Gospel is a combination of two Greek words which means "good news" and "to proclaim." The Gospel came from God Himself. God the Father longed for His lost children and gave the good news as He promised in the Old Testament. It was not invented by the apostles, but a long time ago God already thought of what He will do to bring salvation to the world through His Son, Jesus Christ.

Christ-Centered (Romans 1:3-4)

The apostle Paul defined the Gospel as Jesus Christ's ministry. It is all about Him and what He has done to bring salvation to the world. The Old Testament prophesied about Him as the coming Messiah in 2 Samuel 7:12-13, Isaiah 9:6-7, Daniel 7:13-14. All these point to Jesus Christ and were finally revealed in the New Testament. He is the "Messiah" described in Isaiah 53:5-6 who was pierced, crushed, chastened, and scourged, and all our iniquities fall on Him. Jesus Christ fulfilled these prophecies by His death on the cross and resurrection to life!

Compelled (Romans 1:5, 14-15)

The gospel compels us to obedience. Like Paul, a genuine follower of Jesus is compelled to live by His commands and share the gospel! Sharing the gospel is not optional – it is a responsibility we must be so passionately invested to fulfill. Paul was called crazy by Festus in Athens, he was also sneered at and looked down upon because of what he believed. And yet he exclaimed, "I AM NOT ASHAMED!" Why is he confident? Because it is the power of God that rules over him! If we truly love Jesus, we will joyfully and faithfully obey and share the good news to others at all costs.

Power of God to Save (Romans 1:16)

People in Rome understand many kinds of powers, but Paul wants them to embrace the greatest power – the power to change lives. That is the power of the gospel. it changes

hearts. It heals brokenness. It restores. But there is a condition to this power: while it is offered to everyone, one must be able to believe it. What is the gospel saving us from? It saves us from the penalty of sin – the wrath of God (justification). It sanctifies us from the power of sin (sanctification) and perfectly rids us of the presence of sin (glorification).

Righteousness of God (Romans 1:17)

The righteousness of God is not just about the perfection in all He does or that He is always correct. It is more than that. It means that His manner of justice is also righteous. At the cross, justice and mercy met. There is forgiveness. Our own human righteousness will never be enough to reach heaven but only the righteousness that comes through faith in Christ (1 Corinthians 1:30-31).


