LAST WEEK'S MESSAGE



Have you ever thought about the kind of life God wants us to live? God wants us to have a meaningful and purposeful life full of joy and peace, and Jesus said that we could have this life "and have it abundantly" (John 10:10).

How can we be able to live this kind of life?

SURRENDER (ROMANS 12:1)

Paul begins Romans 12:1 with an appeal to think of the mercies of God — which he described in the previous chapters of Romans — and to PRESENT our bodies as a living and holy sacrifice acceptable to God. This is an act of complete surrender to the Lord, and it is choosing to do the things that please and honor Him. In Matthew 16:24-26, Jesus tells us what surrender looks like: it is to deny ourselves, take up our cross, and follow Him. God wants our best, and the only way to give our best to Him is to die to ourselves.

Paul also calls presenting our bodies to God as a "spiritual service of worship". It is living a life that worships God daily and moment-by-moment, not just once a week, and where we give our best in all we do as unto Him—including menial work. Furthermore, a life of complete surrender is when sin is farthest from our mind.

SEPARATE (ROMANS 12:2)

Romans 12:2 gives us a reminder NOT TO BE CONFORMED to the ways of the world. Today, Satan has captured the minds of many, and we will never learn to recognize his lies until we know and embrace the TRUTH that sets us free (John 8:32)! We cannot allow ourselves to be influenced by social media, the people we meet, and the environment we live and work in, as they often force us to fit into a mold to appear like everybody else. Instead of copying the world, we are to be set apart from it. We need to BE TRANSFORMED by God's Spirit and His word for us to experience true freedom (2 Corinthians 3:16-18). Joshua 1:8 reminds us to meditate on the Word day and night. We must allow SOUND THINKING based on God's TRUTH to permeate our minds and lives daily.

SERVE (ROMANS 12:3-8)

Romans 12:3 urges us to think properly, neither overestimating nor underestimating ourselves, and to use our God-given gift and abilities to serve others (1 Corinthians 12:14-18, Ephesians 4:11-13, and 1 Peter 4:10-11). God designed us for different purposes, but we are all designed to ultimately serve Him. Serving the Lord and focusing on others rather than ourselves is good for us and makes us happy Christians.

Our God who bestows favor and honor would not withhold any good thing from those who trust in Him (Psalm 84:11-12). When we understand that God wants what is best for us, we will genuinely surrender our lives to Him and serve Him. We will have the confidence to go wherever He wants us to go and do whatever He wants us to do.
