LAST WEEK'S MESSAGE

A life surrendered to Christ is a transformed life. How does a transformed life look like? What did Jesus say should every Christian be known for? How can we be able to live this kind of life?

LOVE YOUR FAMILY (ROMANS 12:9-16)

We are to "be devoted to one another in brotherly love". The Greek word for devoted is "philostorgos" from "phileo" (brotherly love), and "storge" (love for family). This describes something very special about our relationship with other believers.

Be Sincere (v.12:9a) - Love must be without hypocrisy. It must be genuine and with sincerity. Judas, the disciple who betrayed Jesus, exemplified hypocrisy. We should not be like Judas — let's be like Jesus instead!

Be Discerning (v.12:9b) – We are to avoid evil at all costs and "cling to what is good". It's getting harder these days to know what is good and evil, but we have God's Word that enables us to discern right from wrong.

Be Affectionate (v.12:10a) - God tells us to love each other with kindness and tenderness. Not all of us come from wonderful physical families, but if you are in Christ, we are brothers and sisters.

Be Respectful (v.12:10b) - To give preference to one another is like competing to be the first to honor others. We don't see this kind of love too often in church because we don't know how to love, but this is how God called us to love one another.

Be Enthusiastic (v.12:11) - Be passionate in showing love and serving others. After all, it is the Lord that we are serving.

Be Patient (v.12:12) – To rejoice in hope, persevere in tribulation, and to be devoted in prayer means that we are to have a future view in mind because for those who are in Christ, the best is yet to come!

Be Generous (v.12:13a) - There are needs all around us. Give what you can give. Be generous with your time,

talent, and treasure for God loves a cheerful giver!

Be Hospitable (v.12:13b) - "Philoxenia" means love for strangers and guests, and this is the Greek word used for hospitality. Let's open our hearts and homes to welcome guests and minister to them.

Be Benevolent (v.12:14) - We are to be gracious to bless and not curse those who persecute us.

Be Sympathetic (v.12:15) - When our brother or sister does well in life, we are to rejoice with them wholeheartedly. When they weep, we mourn and grieve with them.

Be Harmonious (v.12:16a) - In God's family, we are to look for what we have in common. Being divisive is not characteristic of Christlike love

Be Humble (v.12:16b) - In God's family, there are no more divisions based on race or social class. Be in a posture of humility. Listen to other people and consider others as more important than ourselves.

LOVE YOUR ENEMIES (ROMANS 12:14, 17-21)

Romans 12:3 urges us to think properly, neither overestimating nor underestimating ourselves, and to use our God-given gift and abilities to serve others (1 Corinthians 12:14-18, Ephesians 4:11-13, and 1 Peter 4:10-11). God designed us for different purposes, but we are all designed to ultimately serve Him. Serving the Lord and focusing on others rather than ourselves is good for us and makes us happy Christians.

Our God who bestows favor and honor would not withhold any good thing from those who trust in Him (Psalm 84:11-12). When we understand that God wants what is best for us, we will genuinely surrender our lives to Him and serve Him. We will have the confidence to go wherever He wants us to go and do whatever He wants us to do.
