

God's heart is for us to be united by love. But when love is hard, how do we keep on loving? Paul tells us in Ephesians 4:1-3 to "walk in a manner worthy of the calling", having tolerance for one another in love. In the same way, Jesus' command in John 13:34-35 to love one another is not about feelings: it is an intentional act of considering others as more important and a conscious decision to pursue love even when it's difficult, so that we will be known as Christ's disciples. How do we do this?

PURSUE BUILDING UP

In Romans 14:19-21, Paul continues the instruction to love by building others up rather than making them stumble. We are to give our full energy to build others up by being conscious about their needs, allowing them to grow in their faith and not forcing our own way. We should not impose on others our own convictions, beliefs and things we feel strongly about that we developed over the years of walking with the Lord. In 1 Corinthians 8:1,4, 7-13, Paul reminded the Corinthians about the importance of knowledge and its dangers of making someone proud. True spirituality is becoming more like Jesus, loving and caring for others more. If we are truly mature Christians, we would limit our liberty for the sake of those who are young in the faith. In 1 Corinthians 10:28-29, Paul reinforces that for conscience's sake, we are to be more willing to build up others. Strong believers must be able to love those weaker in the faith — to love others from a pure heart, a pure conscience, and sincere faith (1 Timothy 1:5-6,19).

PRIORITIZE OTHERS

Romans 15:1-3 reminds us to prioritize others. Paul is addressing those who are strong in the faith to help the new or weak believers. In Galatians 6:1-2 we are taught to bear one another's burdens, to help others rather than canceling or judging them. To prioritize others is to be patient, listen, understand, and help others be restored. We love others when we genuinely aim for their good and edification. Paul points us to the example of Christ who gave up His own pleasure and instead prioritized the needs of those He came to die for. Philippians 2:1-5 reminds us to follow in the footsteps of Christ, not doing anything from selfishness or pride, but considering others with humility of mind as more important than ourselves. We need to have the attitude of Christ and seek to become more and more like Him every day of our life.

POWERED BY GOD

The Christian life is a supernatural life. We need the power of Christ in us when love does not come easy. Paul in Romans 15:4-6 points out that perseverance, encouragement, and hope come from the Word of God. We don't get it out of people – we get it from God. Being powered by God, His love, and His example through Christ in the flesh enables us to be in one accord and enjoy a harmonious relationship with others through Christ alone. In Romans 15:13, Paul adds the importance of HOPE which we gain by the power of the Holy Spirit, which gives us strength and confidence in the certainty of God's promises.

Having our hope and security in God alone gives us joy and peace. He empowers us to live a blameless life (Acts 24:15-16) as we abide in His word and submit to the leading of the Holy Spirit. Colossians 1:17 clearly tells us where this hope comes from – CHRIST IN US, the hope of glory! This hope enables us to not give up when loving others is hard and to keep love alive!


