BELIEVE and BE SAVED!

LAST WEEK'S MESSAGE

We are all prisoners of sin, but God planned our rescue and sent Jesus to save us. He wants all of us to be saved (2 Peter 3:9), yet we must do our part — to believe in His Son.

TRUST NOT IN SELF-RIGHTEOUSNESS (ROMANS 10:1-5)

The Jews were enthusiastic about God, but they did not have an experiential knowledge of Him (Romans 10:2-3). They had religion, but no relationship with God. They relied on following God's law perfectly thinking that it would save them. They failed to realize that the purpose of the Law is to show what God's will is and our inability to live a holy life apart from Him. Most of all, the purpose of the law is to point us to Christ! The reality is we have all broken God's commands. No one can keep the entire Ten Commandments (James 2:10). We cannot trust in ourselves to be saved — we need Jesus our Savior.

TRUST IN JESUS ALONE (ROMANS 10:6-13)

Paul tells us to "confess... and believe" in the risen King – Jesus Christ – for our salvation. To confess that Jesus is Lord is "to be in full agreement" that we cannot save ourselves. It also means "to celebrate" that He is Lord. To believe in Jesus is to profess conviction that God has invited us to a relational commitment with Him and to declare that we have accepted his invitation (J.I. Packer). To "call" on the name of Jesus is to make a desperate appeal to Him who alone can save us.

TELL OTHERS ABOUT JESUS (ROMANS 10:14-15)

God used someone to tell us about Jesus. Now, it's our turn to "pay it forward" by telling others about Him. Paul quotes from Isaiah 52:7, "How beautiful are the feet of those who spread good news". All who share the good news have beautiful feet in God's eyes! It's not just our responsibility to share Christ to others, it's also our privilege! In fact, it is hypocritical for us to pray according to Matthew 9:36-38 and be unwilling to participate in the answer to the prayer.

THINK: HOW WILL YOU RESPOND? (ROMANS 10:16-21)

How will you respond to the truth about Jesus? How will you respond to His mission to save you? If you are a believer, how will you respond to the challenge that you are sent because people need to hear about Jesus? A practical application for us today is to consider how people look at our lives: would others want to have Jesus too because they see Christ in us and through us? Would there be sufficient evidence that Christ is in us by the way we live?

As Jesus stretches out His nail-pierced hands to us today, let us respond, confess, and believe in Him as our only Lord and Savior. Let's share and pass on the Good News of salvation through Jesus to others!

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

In what or whom are you trusting for your eternal salvation? Explain your answer.

How can you develop greater compassion for those who do not know Jesus as Lord?

What will you do this week to tell someone about Jesus?
