THE BEST ASSURANCE: God is a Promise-Keeper

LAST WEEK'S MESSAGE

In the book of Romans, the apostle Paul dealt with Jewish leaders who were relying on their adherence to the Law, observance of religious rites, and good works for salvation. They were teaching the same to the Gentiles, telling them it is the way for them to be saved. In chapter 4, Paul gave the example of Abraham to show what genuine righteousness in the eyes of God is. Abraham believed God and it was credited to him as righteousness. Paul is telling the Jewish leaders and all of us today that the best assurance of our salvation is God because He is a PROMISE-KEEPER. We can trust His character, power, and timing.

TRUST HIS CHARACTER (ROMANS 4:3-8)

God's character is consistent in the Old Testament until today. God is true to His character. He is who He says He is — perfectly good, just, and loving. If He says Jesus is the only Savior, the way, the truth, and the life, then we must believe that. Abraham believed first before his circumcision. This means we don't work for our salvation. Paul quoted David saying the same thing in Psalm 32:1-2. It is God who justifies the ungodly through faith and not because of works. We need to admit that we can't save ourselves — not human effort or goodness but only through faith in Jesus Christ. If we truly realize how undeserving we are of God's love, we will love Him with all our heart, soul, mind, strength, and experience genuine life transformation.

TRUST HIS POWER (ROMANS 4:9-16)

We can confidently trust in God's power because of His proven track record. Paul wanted the Jews to realize that Abraham's faith in God was what made him righteous. He BELIEVED in God. His circumcision was merely a sign, an outward symbol of his faith, a seal of righteousness that comes through faith which he already had even while he was uncircumcised. Paul is saying that righteousness comes through faith, not by being circumcised. If we can work for our salvation, we don't have any need for grace. Faith and grace go together. The promise of salvation is for everyone, but we need to step out in faith. We need to trust God's power that He can change lives, that He's the only Savior — that His power can work in and through our lives if we only believe.

TRUST HIS TIMING (ROMANS 4:17-25)

God keeps His promises, and His timing is always perfect. God promised Abraham that He would be a father of many nations, and he believed. He waited on the Lord for the promise. He waited for years without weakening his faith. Even when he was of old age, he was still fully convinced that God has power to do as He has promised. This is why it was credited to him by God as righteousness. God is honored when we step out in faith despite the difficulties. He will never leave us.

God looks at us as clean because of our faith. We have the greatest proof that our faith is correct because Jesus died and rose again. The resurrection of Jesus is the ultimate proof that our faith in Him is not futile. Jesus is the only person who lived on earth who spoke about his death and resurrection and was able to pull it off! Only Jesus will bring us to heaven.

Step in faith and hold on to His ways for He will always be faithful!


