LAST WEEK'S MESSAGE

1 Corinthians 13, one of the most famous chapters in the Bible, gives the greatest description of LOVE (vv. 4-7) with 15 verbs to describe it. It begins with Paul making a very important point (vv. 1-2): even if we have the gift of tongues, prophecy, knowledge, and faith, but we do not have LOVE, we “are nothing.” Even if we are generous givers, willing to sacrifice ourselves as martyrs, but do not have love, there is no profit in that (v. 3). When we think of Christ, the Greatest Person and Lover of all time, He exhibited a different level of love. We must grow into Christlikeness and love others according to His example. As David Jeremiah said, “Love is worthless unless it’s expressed in deed and behavior.”

What love is...

Love is PATIENT and KIND (1 Corinthians 13:4). “Patient” in Greek is *makrothumeo* – long-suffering. People long to love and be loved, but the hurdle is our own imperfections. God’s amazing love is that He chose to love us despite our imperfections. We must be patient with others if we want to love. “Kind” in Greek is *chresteuomai*. Christians were once called *chrestinai* – a combined word describing one who is full of kindness and grace (Romans 2:4). Are we patient and kind to others even in challenging situations and when interacting with frustrating people?

What love is not...

Love is not JEALOUS (Gk. zeloo) (1 Corinthians 13:4). This is different from jealousy that protects (God is a jealous God, meaning protective ownership). When others are blessed, be happy and rejoice with those who rejoice. Let us not be covetous.

Love does not BRAG (Gk. perpereuomai). We often mistakenly take credit for things that happen to us and even brag about it (culture sometimes calls it “humble bragging”). **Love is also not ARROGANT (Gk. phusioo).** Arrogance is something we must all avoid. Deuteronomy 8:14-18 reminds us that God is the one who gives us power, and the ability to make wealth, so all credit belongs to God!

Love does not ACT UNBECOMINGLY (Gk. aschemoneo) (1 Corinthians 13:5). We should not be rude nor

act in a way that doesn’t reflect Jesus. **Love does not SEEK ITS OWN (Gk. zeteo)** insisting its own way with selfishness.

Love is not PROVOKED (Gk. paroxuno), or quickly irritated. Instead, love empowers us to withhold our words first and avoid being reactive.

Love does not TAKE INTO ACCOUNT (Gk. logizomai) a wrong suffered, not counting mistakes and keeping records of wrongs; instead keeping good relationships. God is after our character and allows challenges to make us better Christians. God will vindicate us from these challenges someday, but until then, let us not allow these to destroy our testimonies.

Love does not REJOICE IN UNRIGHTEOUSNESS but instead rejoices in the truth (1 Corinthians 13:6). Proverbs 24:17 tells us not to rejoice when our enemies have problems. Love covers a multitude of sins (1 Peter 4:8) – there is forgiveness and grace, but we must stick to what is right in the sight of God.

All of these are made possible through the transformative power of the Holy Spirit as outlined in Galatians 5:22-23. This passage refers to the “fruit of the Spirit,” which is not just a collection of separate traits but a combination of all these good qualities working together in us. All these qualities are possible because of the power of the Holy Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23). It’s important to know that we can’t develop these qualities on our own. We need God’s help, and when we let Him work in us, Christ’s character shines through us.

Finally, Paul also expressed what love should always do and what we should always strive to do: **Love BEARS (Gk. stego), BELIEVES (Gk. pisteuo), HOPES (Gk. elpizo), and ENDURES (Gk. hupomeno) ALL THINGS.** We must believe people can change by the power of God! He who began a good work in us will be faithful to COMPLETE it (Philippians 1:6). **True love NEVER FAILS (Gk. pipto).** God never fails – so we follow what Jesus commanded – to do unto others what we want to be done to us. It’s about living a life that reflects the brand of love that Christ taught us and putting this love into ACTION.

Last Week's Memory Verse

Love is patient, love is kind and is not jealous; love does not brag and is not arrogant, does not act unbecomingly; it does not seek its own, is not provoked, does not take into account a wrong suffered, does not rejoice in unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth; bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

1 CORINTHIANS 13:4-7
