The Resurrection: Love Brings Hope

LAST WEEK'S MESSAGE

Jesus died on the cross, but He did not stay dead! Love brings hope, but how and why does the Resurrection bring us hope? Biblical hope is very different from our common understanding of the word as merely a wish. In the Bible, hope is a certainty – the assurance of what God has promised, and its strength is in His faithfulness. The resurrection of Jesus is crucial to Christian hope, as it assures us of eternal life and God's promise as stated in 1 Peter 1:3-4.

Our Foundation is Firm — Jesus is God

Our foundation is not a "what," but a "who"; our foundation is Jesus! There are many who do not believe, or could not care less, that Jesus is God. But for those who know and believe, "Life with Christ is an endless hope; without Him, a hopeless end." Christ's death and resurrection were pointed to and promised in the Old Testament (1 Corinthians 15:3-4, Isaiah 53:10). Today, God continues to draw people from all walks of life all over the world to Himself; this is made possible because of the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Jesus is God; He could not have risen from the dead if it were not so (Psalm 16:10, Acts 13:35-37). Jesus constantly reminded His disciples about how He would fulfill prophecy regarding His death and resurrection (Matthew 16:21). We may agree intellectually that Jesus is divine, but it doesn't really make a difference until we make Him the Savior and Lord of our life. We need to accept Him, worship Him, and give our lives to Him as our God.

Our Faith is Certain

The apostle Paul discusses the futility of believers preaching about the resurrection if the resurrection of Jesus did not happen (1 Corinthians 15:12-19). The good news is that Jesus did rise again! The entire Bible speaks about and points to Jesus. He is the Living Word of God; to know Jesus, we need to know the Word of God (the Bible), so that we will know the God of the Word.

Our eternal destiny is completely dependent on the resurrection of Jesus (Romans 10:9-10). Our salvation is by God's grace through faith in Jesus alone, and not from our own good works (Ephesians 2:8-10). Good works are not to help us get saved; they are the fruit, or overflow, of a

life that has already been saved by Jesus!

Our Forgiveness is Complete

When Jesus said, "It is finished," as He hung on the cross, He was declaring to God that He had accomplished the task given to Him. This phrase translates to a single Greek word, "tetelestai," which means "to bring to an end, to complete, to fulfill." When Jewish priests inspected a sacrificial animal brought by the people for offering at the temple, they would declare "tetelestai" if the animal was found perfect, with no defect, and approved for sacrifice. In a business transaction, after goods or debts have been paid, the document is marked "tetelestai": paid in full. We owe a debt of sin to God that we have no way of paying, and Jesus was the One who paid it all. The connection between our forgiveness and Christ's resurrection is very clear, and His death and resurrection are inseparable (Romans 4:25). Our justification — the act of pronouncing righteous acquittal, a process of absolution - our being declared "not guilty" before God, is based on Jesus' death and resurrection. Jesus paid for ALL our sins - past, present, and future!

Our Future is Secure

Those who have a relationship with Jesus (believers in Christ) have been promised imperishable bodies when Jesus takes us up to be with Him forever "at the last trumpet" (1 Corinthians 15:50-55). The victory belongs to Jesus, and that's why we know that our future is secure! God assures us "there is more" in our future with Him. If you're going through something difficult, be comforted by His promise for our future with Him (1 Thessalonians 4:16-18). The resurrection is a message of love that brings genuine hope!

Two thousand years ago, the sun rose in the east, just like any other morning. But it wasn't just an ordinary morning: Jesus' followers discovered that the stone sealing His tomb had been rolled away, revealing an empty grave (Luke 24:1-6). Jesus wasn't there — He had risen! Give your life to the Resurrected Christ today!

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to obtain an inheritance which is imperishable and undefiled and will not fade away, reserved in heaven for you, who are protected by the power of God through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.
