

Bless the Lord Always!

LAST WEEK'S MESSAGE

Psalm 103 was written by King David in his later years when he was preparing to pass the throne to his son, Solomon. Having lived through his fair share of experiences – battles, personal failures, moments of triumph, and more – David's central message in this psalm is simple but powerful: "Bless the Lord, always!" But what does it look like to constantly bless the Lord? David shows us three ways to do this.

Inward: Recall What God Has Done (vv. 1-5)

To "bless" the Lord means to focus on Him fully, worshipping with our whole heart and soul. David begins the psalm by recalling God's goodness to him. God forgave his sins (even his adultery and murder), healed him, and showed compassion to him. We too are called to remember God's work in our lives. David likely even remembered praying for his dying infant son, and even in grief, he worshiped God, trusting in eternity (2 Samual 12:20-23). Corrie Ten Boom, a Holocaust survivor, exemplified this mindset. She chose to remember God's blessings even in prison and later forgave her abuser. Like her and David, we are called to reflect on God's goodness amid hardship.

Upward: Reflect On Who God Is (vv. 6-19)

Are we more focused on our problems than on God's character? David reminds us that even if our situations don't change, worship is more than capable of shifting our perspective. God is just, merciful, and full of "hesed" - His loyal, covenant love. David describes God's love to be as vast as the heavens and His forgiveness as far-reaching as the east is from the west. God is compassionate and understanding, despite our weaknesses. He knows our fragility and rules overall. His mercy, justice, and compassion all point back to His steadfast love, which He ultimately shows us through Jesus Christ (Romans 5:8).

Outward: Radiate Worship (vv. 20-22)

David ends his psalm by calling all creation to worship. When we recall what God has done and who He is, outward worship naturally follows. When was the last time you shared Jesus with a friend, family member, or even just online? Do others see God through you, your life, and your choices? God's ultimate desire is for all creation to worship Him (Revelation 5:13). One day, every knee will bow, so why not start now? So great is His lovingkindness; bless the Lord, always!
