# **GOD IS LOVE, LOVE LIKE GOD**

As Christians, do we find ourselves challenged to love? Since love is God's core attribute, we are always eager to experience His great, unfailing love. But how do we reflect that love in our relationships with others? The answer lies in personally and intimately experiencing God's love—truly "knowing" the Lord—so that we can love others as He does (1 John 4:8). God's love is neither static nor conflicted. His attributes exist in perfect harmony, so everything He does is as loving as it is just and right.

### **GOD'S LOVE THROUGH THE AGES**

God consistently reveals His love throughout the Bible—through both His pursuit and His promises. In the Old Testament, the story of the prophet Hosea and his unfaithful wife, Gomer, illustrates God's love for Israel. His persistent pursuit shows that His love is unwavering, redeeming Israel from its idols through the precious blood of Christ (1 Peter 1:18–19). God's holiness, combined with His love, results in His discipline. When we deliberately go astray, we can be certain of His correction (Hebrews 12:5–6).

In the story of the Passover, we learn that until we are desperate to be freed from the slavery of sin, we will not recognize the solution of His deliverance. We must paint our own spiritual doorposts with the blood of an innocent lamb (Exodus 12:13). We must humble ourselves, abandon worldly responses, and center our hearts on accepting our one and only God. Centuries later, the New Testament describes Jesus as our Passover Lamb—God's only solution for our sins (1 Corinthians 5:7–8).

## **GOD'S LOVE THROUGH HIS SON**

Through His greatest act of love, God shows how His attributes—such as love and wrath—are intertwined. By sending Jesus Christ as a sacrifice for our sins, God demonstrates that while His wrath disciplines the sin of man, His love still provides the path to salvation (1 John 4:10). Just as the Lord provided clothing for Adam and Eve as they left the Garden of Eden (Genesis 3:7, 21), Jesus' blood now allows us to enter the kingdom of God (Hebrews 10:19–20).

### **GOD'S LOVE THROUGH YOU & ME**

To walk in God's love is to follow His lead and love others as He loves us. Loving like God is not easy, but once we surrender to the Lord, we begin a journey of knowing Him and discovering opportunities to love like Him in every area of our lives (1 John 4:7). If we are unwilling to love as our Lord does, we will never truly know Him.

We are called to make disciples! In spreading the gospel, we also spread the love of God. We take on the mantle of a Christ-filled life and strive to live each day worthy of our Father. As we celebrate CCF's 41st Anniversary, let us remember: God is love—so let us love like God!
