

TURN YOUR FEAR INTO FAITH

Every believer has a purpose designed by God, but too often, fear stops us from stepping into it. Like Timothy, we may feel too young, unqualified, or overwhelmed by the challenges around us. Yet God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power, love, and discipline! When we say yes to His call and walk in faith, we discover that He has already given us everything we need to fulfill His perfect plan. Let's learn how God empowers us through the Apostle Paul's last letter to Timothy.

GOD'S GIFTS

Sometimes, we might not listen to God's calling because we don't believe we have what it takes to listen. Like Timothy, who faced great challenges in Ephesus, we can struggle with fear of opposition or even fear of insecurity in our resources, time, and skills to obey. In Timothy 1:7, Paul reminds Timothy that God gifts His children with a spirit of power, love, and discipline to fulfill His purpose! God strengthens us not to shrink from daunting tasks, but to stay faithful because He already provides for everything we need.

GOD'S GRACE

In his letter, Paul reminded Timothy to "be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus" (2 Timothy 2:1). It is by grace that we can accomplish God's will, endure hardships, and press on in our mission (2 Timothy 2:2-4). Just like athletes, we need to discipline ourselves and persevere — yet empowered fully by God's grace. The ultimate

display of grace was Jesus' sacrifice, and it is because of this grace that we can turn fear into faith.

GOD'S GUIDANCE

God, in His goodness, makes sure that we do not have to brave this world and its challenges alone. Paul warned Timothy in his letter that difficult times would come, but that when they did, God's Word and godly mentorship would be essential for guidance. Amidst the deceit of this world, we must anchor and ground ourselves in the truth of Scripture and practice discernment in choosing godly mentors that can guide us just as Paul guided Timothy. As Charles Spurgeon eloquently said, "A Bible that's falling apart usually belongs to someone who isn't."

GOD'S GLORY

When our suffering and anxieties exhaust us, God's promises to us motivate us to keep moving forward! As Paul neared the end of his life, he encouraged Timothy to endure hardships and remain faithful through every season. Even though great opposition would come, Timothy could persevere knowing that God's glory awaits those who faithfully follow His calling (2 Timothy 4:6-7). A heavenly reward awaits those who fulfill God's call: Jesus (2 Timothy 4:8)! By His grace, let's step into faith, obey His will, and live for His glory.

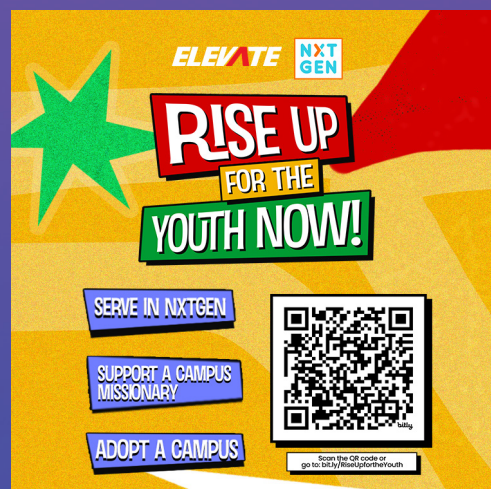

God brought you here for His purpose.

God loves you.

He desires for you to have a meaningful life with Him in the present and gain eternal life with Him in the future.

Know therefore that the Lord your God, He is God, the faithful God, who **keeps His covenant and His lovingkindness** to a thousandth generation with those who love Him and keep His commandments — Deuteronomy 7:9

God is holy.

We are sinful, and our sin separates us from Him.
