

LET JESUS BRING YOU FROM DARKNESS TO LIGHT

Darkness brings sorrow, but the greatest darkness we face is not physical, but spiritual. Many live in this darkness without realizing it, and only Jesus can bring us into the light. Jesus declared that He is the Light of the world, and that whoever follows Him will have the light of life (John 8:12). Our confidence in this truth rests on God's past promises, our present experience of Christ, and the future glory that awaits us.

promises to guide their steps (James 1:5; Isaiah 30:21). As Mighty God, He is the creator and sustainer of all things, and the One who holds our lives together (John 1:1-4; Colossians 1:16-17). As Everlasting Father, He reveals the heart of God and brings us into close fellowship with Him (Hebrews 1:3; John 10:14-15). As Prince of Peace, He reconciles us to God and gives peace to our troubled hearts (Romans 5:1; John 14:27).

PAST PROMISES

Isaiah foretold of a great light shining during a time of judgment. Even when Israel had turned from God, resulting in the Assyrian invasion, God promised that light would shine on those living in sorrow and death (Isaiah 9:2). God fulfilled this promise through Jesus, yet darkness still surrounds us through corruption, suffering, and fear. Jesus warned of an even greater darkness – eternal separation from God (Matthew 25:30). Jesus came to rescue us from that judgment and to bring God's presence, salvation, and lasting joy into our present darkness (Isaiah 9:2-3).

FUTURE GLORY

We can trust God's promises because God Himself will establish Jesus' eternal kingdom (Isaiah 9:7). In our eternal home, Jesus will be our everlasting light (Revelation 21:22-23). Until that day, He calls us to reflect His light by pointing others to Him (Matthew 5:14, 16). If you need God's light today, ask Jesus to bring you out of darkness into light, just as He did at creation when He spoke light into existence (Genesis 1:1-3). Let the light of Christ shine through your life this Christmas and in every season.

PRESENT BLESSINGS

Isaiah described the Messiah as Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, and Prince of Peace (Isaiah 9:6). As our counselor, Jesus gives wisdom to those who seek Him and


