

REAL FAITH WALKS IN GOD'S WISDOM

We live in an age of unlimited information. We can cross continents in seconds and access more knowledge than any generation before us. But information isn't wisdom. The book of James reminds us that real wisdom starts when we humbly admit what we lack and trust the One who lacks nothing (Prov 4:1-7). While knowledge may fill the mind, it is godly wisdom that transforms the heart.

SHOWS IN HUMBLE ACTIONS

Wisdom is not proven by what we say, but by how we live (James 3:13). We can spend our entire lives searching for knowledge but still miss or resist God. We see this in Solomon who asked for wisdom yet later drifted from God. In contrast, David sinned deeply but returned in repentance. The difference wasn't in knowledge; it was in humility. God's wisdom is revealed when we surrender our pride, admit we don't have all the answers, and respond with repentance instead of defensiveness.

SHAPES CHRISTLIKE CHARACTER

James warns of another kind of wisdom, a wisdom that is rooted in envy and selfish ambition (James 3:14). As humans, our motives tend to gravitate

towards our self-interest. This is earthly wisdom – a wisdom driven by human desires. In the face of earthly wisdom, James calls us to not be led astray and to carefully watch what is shaping our character. God's wisdom plants righteousness slowly shapes our character into Christlikeness.

STRENGTHENS RELATIONSHIPS

What causes our relationships to break? James answers plainly: it's our own selfish desires (James 4:2). No matter how long we walk with Jesus, we will still battle with our old nature, and when we insist on our own way, fights follow. When we surrender our desires to God, peace grows. Godly wisdom teaches us to pause, pray, and yield, not so we can win, but so we can honor Him. As we submit our hearts to God, He replaces self-centered desires with Christ-centered ones. And it is that transformation in our hearts strengthens marriages, friendships, and communities.
