

STOP LOOKING, LISTEN: GOD IS ENOUGH

LAST WEEK'S MESSAGE

The culture today does not make it easy to be content with what we have. Social media, online shopping, and constant advertising often make us feel like we need more. When we give in to a covetous spirit, we allow temporary desires to shape how we think and live. Instead of seeking fulfillment in the things of this world, we are called to examine whether our hearts are anchored in the true and lasting satisfaction found only in God (1 John 2:15–17).

BE CONTENT

True contentment is not determined by how much we own, but by knowing that our deepest satisfaction is found in Christ. Working hard and pursuing our goals is not wrong, nor does God say that money itself is evil. The problem begins when we look to wealth, success, or possessions to satisfy what only God can fulfill (1 Timothy 6:10). When we recognize that God is sufficient for everything we need, we can rest in His provision and enjoy His blessings with gratitude (Ecclesiastes 5).

BE GENEROUS

Generosity is the opposite of covetousness. Earthly wealth and possessions hold little value compared to God's eternal purposes; what matters is how we steward what He has entrusted to us (Proverbs 11:4, 24–25). Everything we have comes from Him, and giving is one way we express our gratitude and worship. Whether we have much or little, generosity demonstrates our trust in God's provision and helps shift our focus from temporary possessions to eternal priorities.

BE IN AWE

Just as a child loves, trusts, respects, and reveres a loving father, we are called to live in awe of our Heavenly Father. God gave His commands not to burden us, but to help us know Him, walk in obedience, and experience the blessings that come from living according to His will (Deuteronomy 5:29). This is why we are called to study Scripture—to know God more deeply and draw near to an authentic and intimate relationship with Him (Exodus 20:20–21).
