



#NOTALONE PROGRAM DGROUP PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION GUIDELINES

Ready to reach more **students** for Christ? Want to help **schools, families and communities** to know God? It's super easy! The Dgroup Project resources are designed to help you make disciples together in a simple and fun way, and to encourage the **youth** that, indeed, **they are not alone**.

1. PREPARE

Everything you need for the implementation of the #NotAlone Program is ready for you! This will guide you in conducting #NotAlone Sessions, weekly mentoring activities, and other events. 2. PRAY, PLUG-AND-PLAY

First, **PRAY** and ask the Holy Spirit to guide and empower you on how to take part in reaching out the young generation. Then just **PLUG and PLAY** the videos while following the training manual for facilitators. The training manual includes program profile, session topics with breakout discussion questions after every session, and facilitation guide.

3. PROGRAM FLOW

The Program conducts seven (7) sessions which can be done on a monthly basis for the school year. Each session will include the following: 10 to 15-minute introduction and ice-breaker, 30 to 45-minute talk, and 45-minute breakout activity. Sessions will run for two (2) hours and will be done once a month.

Follow through activities in a small group setting can be done weekly after conducting the once a month sessions. This is for the deepening exercise and application of the lessons and also an opportunity to mentor students for issues or concerns that they may have.

NOTE: Please refrain from removing sessions, changing the order of sessions or compressing or stretching out content that may change the intended progression of the topics and activities that were designed for maximum learning.
